### **GENERAL INFORMATION**




#### **Climate**

The Maltese Islands have a pleasantly sunny climate with an average of 300 sunny days per year.



#### **Documentation**

European residents need a valid identity card.



#### Time difference

Malta is +2 hrs from the GMT time.



#### **Electricity**

The electrical supply is 240 volts, 50 hertz. The three-pin rectangular plug system is used, as in Britain.



The official languages are Maltese and English.



#### **Airport**

Malta International Airport is centrally located 15 minutes from main areas.



#### **Religion & Worship**

The Majority of the Maltese are Roman Catholic, but other religious denominations are also represented.



#### **Currency and banks**

The local currency is the Euro.





#### **AIRPORT TRANSFERS WITH A TWIST**





Instead of the normal modern coaches, we can use vintage cars for a stylish welcome followed by a transfer towards the Grand Harbour of Valletta for a check-in aboard a private Turkish gullet...





#### **CHECK-IN IN STYLE**

A Turkish Gullet will be waiting to take you and your guests on a brief tour of the harbour, disembarking directly at the hotel's jetty for the group check-in all in style. Depending on the time of arrival, drinks and snacks may be served throughout the cruise.









#### ARRIVAL AT ONE OF THE HOTELS

Arrival at the hotel and a private check-in will take place in a reserved area. A welcome drink will be offered to the delegates on the terrace of the hotel (weather permitting and depending on the hotel chosen).

### THE THREE CITIES:

Transfer to the picturesque area in the Southern part of the island known as the 3 cities. This is one of the richest areas on the islands in terms of heritage that was left to us by the Order of the Knights of St. John. These three medieval fortified cities are all connected to one another and overlook the imposing grand harbour. A qualified guide will be with the group throughout the day.

### **BIRGU:**

The tour of Birgu will only last around 30 minutes and clients will be free to walk around the palace on their own should they wish to do so.

#### **VALLETTA:**

Arrival at the capital city of Valletta.




#### GALA DINNER AT THE UPPER BARRAKKA GARDENS

Following the pre-dinner drink, a three or four course menu will be served complimented by 1/2 a bottle of wine, 1/2 a bottle of water and coffee.


